## 1) INTRODUCTION:

The Professor Jayashankar Telangana State Agricultural University is the only State Agricultural University in the state of Telangana which is responsible for education, research and extension in Agriculture and allied fields. The University imparts instruction leading to the Master's degree courses in Agriculture, Agricultural Engineering and Community Science (formerly Home Science) at its constituent Colleges at Hyderabad (Rajendranagar and Saifabad), Jagtial and Sangareddy.

### QUALIFICATIONS:

- Candidates seeking admission into Master's Degree courses must have passed the relevant 4 years Bachelor's Degree examination specified against each course given in the table below from a State Agricultural University (SAU) / Central Agricultural University (CAU)/ institution accredited by ICAR (See Appendix I for local and non-local area specifications).
- The applicants who appeared for ICAR PG-AIEEA (ICAR entrance examination) 2021 only are eligible for admission into Master's Degree Courses.
- For admission into Master's courses, the candidates must have secured a minimum OGPA of 5.50 / 10.00 (SC/ST-5.00/10.00) or 2.50 / 4.00 (SC / ST – 2.00 / 4.00) or 50% marks in traditional system (SC / ST-40%) in the qualifying examination

2) **AGE:** The upper age limit for admission is 40 years as on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2021

3) **RESERVATION FOR CANDIDATES:**

a) **Reservation for Person with Disabilities (PwD)**

1. 3 % seats shall be reserved for Persons with Disabilities (PwD) which shall be kept separate out of the total PG seats offered in each faculty.

2. The candidates seeking reservation under this quota will be required to present himself/herself before a Selection Committee constituted for the purpose to examine the suitability of the candidates to the various courses. The candidates seeking admission into PG courses of PJTSAU will be required to perform a few activities as part of the selection process.

**Visually Handicapped (VH) (1%):** Priority one

Screening Tests: **Task 1:** Reading the information on blackboard/whiteboard from a distance of 9/12/15 feet.; **Task 2:** Writing a small paragraph; **Task 3:** Identification of slides through Microscope

**Hearing Impaired (HI) (1%):** Priority two

Screening Tests: **Task 1:** Listening and writing the word / sentence; **Task 2:** Listening and doing the practical work; **Task 3:** Listening and writing the answers to the questions

**Orthopedically Handicapped (OH) (1%):** Priority three

Screening Tests: **Tasks:** Operation of push/wheel hoes, walking on the bunds, spraying with knapsack/power sprayer, weeding & digging and irrigating the fields

3. The unfilled seats due to non-availability of eligible PwD candidates, shall be filled with the Open Category candidates as per merit rank obtained in the Major subject group, with an allotment of not more than one (1) seat in each department/discipline.

**b) Reservation for SC/ST and BC candidates:**

Reservation of Seats for scheduled castes and scheduled tribes:

Fifteen per cent (15%) and Six per cent (6%) of the seats in each course, after excluding the seats reserved for special category (PwD), in each faculty shall be reserved for the candidates belonging to SCs & STs respectively. If any seats reserved for the Scheduled Tribes could not be filled up due to non-availability of eligible candidates, they will be thrown open to the candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and vice-versa. If eligible SC/ST candidates are not available, these reserved seats will be diverted to open competition and filled on the basis of merit.

Reservation of Seats for Backward Classes:

Twenty nine percent (29%) of the seats in each course after excluding the seats reserved for special categories shall be reserved for BC categories i.e. (BC-A:7%, BC-B:10%, BC-C:1%, BC-D:7%, BC-E:4%).

If qualified candidates belonging to Backward class of a particular group are not available, the leftover seats shall be filled up with the candidates of next group in alphabetical order.

If qualified eligible candidates belonging to Backward classes are not available to fill up seats reserved for them, the unfilled seats shall be filled up with candidates of open category.

As it is not possible to represent all social groups in a single major field in courses

with more than one major subject, candidates belonging to different social groups shall be distributed in different major subjects of study available in such courses.

The Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Class candidates in support of their claims shall furnish a Certificate in the prescribed format.

The genuineness of the claim of the social status shall be referred to the respective Directors viz., Director of Social Welfare and Director of Backward Classes whose decision on this subject shall be final and binding on the candidates. The admission to the seats reserved to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes shall be deemed provisional till the receipt of the report from the respective Directors.

**c) Reservations for EWS Candidates:**

EWS Reservation shall be applicable as per the orders and guidelines issued by Telangana Government from time to time. Unfilled seats, if any shall not be filled with candidates from any other category.

**d) Reservation of seats for Women:**

There shall be reservation of 33.33 % of seats in favour of women candidates in each course and in each category (OC/SC/ST/BC/PH). The above reservation shall not be applicable if women candidates selected on merit in each category exceeds 33.33 %.

**e) Reservation of seats in favor of Local / Non-Local candidates**

The admission to 85% of the total available seats shall be reserved for the local candidates (Osmania University area, Telangana State) and the remaining 15% of the seats shall be un-reserved (these seats can be filled with candidates from both States of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh based on Merit) as specified in the Presidential Order 371 Article D in consonance of Section 95 of the A.P. Reorganization Act, 2014.

In the case of candidates who passed qualifying examination for admission into PG courses from a State Agricultural University (SAU) / Central Agricultural University (CAU) / institution accredited by ICAR, only the period of study prior to joining such University / Institute will be reckoned for determining the Local/ Non-local status of the candidate.

The following categories of candidates will be considered against 15% of the available seats left **Un-Reserved (UR)**.

- a) All candidates belonging to Telangana and Andhra Pradesh States.
- b) Candidates who have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of study outside the State or either of whose parents have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding period of employment outside the State;
- c) Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and similar other Quasi- Government Institutions within the State. Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State or Central Government, Public Sector, Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and similar other Quasi-Government Institutions with in the state.

- d) Candidates who are employees in the State, Central Government undertakings, Public Sector Corporations, Local e) Bodies, Universities and other similar Quasi-public Institutions with in the state.

#### **6) CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:**

- a) The selection shall be based on the previous academic record at Under Graduate level and performance (marks) in the entrance test conducted by ICAR through **ICAR AIEEA (PG) 2021** and the weightage will be in the ratio of 30:70, respectively. The candidates who have appeared for the entrance test in a major subject group will not be permitted to interchange to any other major subject group. The identified subject groups only will be considered for admissions. Based on the **merit rank arrived through the stipulated formula**, the candidate will be allowed to take admission in a specific sub-subject (discipline) at PJTSAU as per the choice of the candidate and availability of seat at that merit rank through an **offline** counselling process.
- b) Male candidates are also eligible for admission into M.Sc. (Community Science- formerly Home Science) in Foods & Nutrition Course only.
- c) In case of SC/ST candidates, there **shall be no minimum qualifying marks to the extent of seats reserved for them.**
- d) In case of a tie, candidate who secures more marks at M.Sc. level shall be preferred. In case of a further tie, marks obtained at B.Sc. level shall be considered. For further tie breaking, date of birth shall be considered and older candidate shall be preferred.
- e) The admission shall be through **offline** counselling. The merit list of eligible candidates shall be displayed on the University Notice Board and also be placed on University website. The selected candidates shall submit required original certificates, pay the prescribed fee in full and secure the admission.

#### **7) CERTIFICATES / DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:**

##### **AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION:**

Only **copies** of the following documents shall be enclosed to the application.

(Documents enclosed to the application will not be returned):

- a) e-Admit Card of AIEEA (PG)- 2021 and ICAR-Entrance Score card issued to qualified candidates)
- b) Memoranda of marks (all years) obtained at the qualifying Under Graduate level examination in case of PG courses
- c) Provisional / degree certificate of the qualifying examination.
- d) Study certificates from Heads of recognized educational institutions from VI class onwards (Those who appeared for any examination by private study should enclose residence certificate).
- e) Social Status Certificates issued by the competent authority on or after **1<sup>st</sup> January 2021** in case of candidates belonging to BC / SC / ST. The admission given under this quota shall be provisional till the genuineness of the social status claim of the candidate is certified by the respective Directorate of the Government.
- f) Date of birth certificate
- g) Certificate of disability for PwD
- h) Residence Certificate (Latest certificate issued on or after **1<sup>st</sup> January of 2021** by the Telangana Government).
- i) Aadhaar Card or 28-digit Aadhaar Enrolment ID proof or Passport or Ration card or

Bank Passbook or any other valid Govt. Identity proof.

- j) Conduct/Bonafide certificate from the Head of the institute last attended.

**AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION:**

Candidates who are selected for admission should submit the following certificates/documents in **original** at the time of admission **in addition to the originals of the certificates listed above.**

- a) **Migration certificate** if the candidate has passed from an University other than PJTSAU.  
b) **Transfer Certificate** from the College / Institution where the candidate last attended

**8) GENERAL:**

- a) The University does not offer any financial assistance to the post-graduate students. However, the post-graduate students may avail the financial assistance either in the shape of stipends or long- term loans, if offered by government or any other agencies on such terms and conditions as prescribed by the respective agencies.
- b) If a particular course is offered in more than one college, allotment of students to a college shall be based on the merit/rule of reservation and availability of seat. **Students admitted to M. Tech. (Agril. Engg.) degree programme in Soil and Water Engineering shall be under the administrative and technical control of Associate Dean, College of Agricultural Engineering, Kandi, Sangareddy. Students admitted to M. Tech. (Agril. Engg.) degree programme in Farm Machinery & Power Engineering and Processing and Food Engineering shall be under the administrative and technical control of Associate Dean, College of Agricultural Engineering, Bapatla, ANGRAU.**
- c) The student should not register for any other degree/diploma programme concurrently on regular or part-time basis either in this University or in any other University/Educational Institution.
- d) The candidate who has been admitted in the Master's programme at PJTSAU but does not complete the requirements or withdraws from the course for not maintaining minimum OGPA will have to apply again by re-appearing for Entrance exam conducted by ICAR in the subsequent year and seek admission afresh. The stipend if any paid earlier shall be recovered in full from the candidate.
- e) All admissions shall be deemed as provisional and subject to further scrutiny. The admission shall be liable for cancellation without notice at any stage during the study period of the students if it is found that the admission was in any way repugnant to the rules/regulations or invalid by reason of incorrect or false information furnished by the applicants or their parents/guardians at the time of admission.
- f) Any cancellation of admission shall not exclude penal action under the relevant criminal law.
- g) The University reserves to itself the right to vary or cancel any of the rules without notice.
- h) Hostel accommodation shall be provided subject to availability.

**9) FEES:**

- a) Details of the amount of fees payable at the time of admission are furnished at

- b) **Students selected for admission shall pay the entire fees at the time of counselling itself.**

- The University will send SMS to the applicants for the purposes related to counselling. Hence the candidates are informed to mention their personal mobile numbers but not the mobile numbers of relatives, friends, net/online/xerox centers etc.
- The Counselling/Verification under special categories (PwD) will be held in the presence of authorities concerned and seats will be allotted as per the priorities indicated by the officers concerned.
- If the admitted candidate cancels his/her seat before the closure of admissions for the Academic Year 2021-22, seat cancellation fee shall be collected as processing fee (given in Appendix II). The remaining fees already paid during admission shall be refunded.
- Candidates shall have to attend to the counselling at their own cost only.
- The University does not guarantee any employment to the candidates.
- The applicant is informed that mere submission of an online application and attending for counselling do not guarantee the allotment of seat.

## APPENDIX I

### Reservation of seats in favour of Local / Non-Local candidates

(In accordance with the A.P Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions) Order, 1974.)

- A** i) After bifurcation of AP State, a new University namely Professor Jayashankar Telangana State Agricultural University (PJ TSAU) was formed. Admission to 85% of the seats after excluding those reserved for the candidates from outside the State, shall be reserved in favour of and allocated among the **local candidates** in relation to the local area in respect of the **Osmania University**.

Among the seats allotted to respective States, the local seats (85%) will be filled by the respective Universities of the respective States. The remaining 15% of unreserved (non-local) seats will be filled in open competition for both the States.

While determining the number of seats to be reserved in favour of the local candidates under Sub-para (i) any fraction of a seat shall be counted as one provided that there shall be at least one unreserved seat.

While allocating under Sub-para (i) the reserved seats among the local candidates in relation to the different local areas, fraction of a seat shall be adjusted by counting the greatest fraction as one and if necessary also the greater of the remaining fractions as another, and where the fraction to be so counted cannot be selected by reason of the fractions being equal, the selection shall be made by lot, provided that there shall be at least one seat allocated for local candidates in respect of each local area.

If a local candidate in respect of a local area is not available to fill any seat reserved or allocated in favour of a local candidate in respect of local area, such seat shall be filled as if it had not been reserved.

#### Local Candidates

1. A candidate for admission to any course of study shall be regarded as a local candidate in relation to a local area:

a) If he/she has studied in an educational institution or educational institutions in such local area for a period of not less than four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared, or as the case may be, first appeared in the relevant qualifying examination

**OR**

b) Where, during the whole or any part of the four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or, as the case may be, first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he/she has not studied in any educational institution, if he/she has resided in that local area for a period of not less than four years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination in which he/she appeared or, as the case may be, first appeared;

2. A candidate for admission to any course of study who is not regarded as a local candidate under sub-paragraph (1) in relation to any local area shall;

a) If he/she has studied in educational institutions in the State for a period of not less than seven consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or, as the case maybe, first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination be regarded as a local candidate in relation to;

i) Such local area where he/she has studied for the maximum period out of the said period of seven years;

**OR**

ii) Where the periods of his/her study in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he has studied last in such equal periods.

**OR**

b) If, during the whole or any part of the seven consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be, first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he/she has not studied in the educational institutions in any local area, but has resided in the State during the whole of the said period of seven years, be regarded as a local candidate in relation to:

i) Such local area where he/she has resided for the maximum period out of the said period of seven years;

**OR**

ii) Where the periods of his/her residence in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he/she has resided last in such equal periods.

**Explanation:** For the purpose of this paragraph.

- i) “educational institution” means a University or any educational institutions recognized by the State Government or a University or other competent authority;
- ii) “relevant qualifying examination” in relation to admission to any course of study, means a pass in the exam which is minimum educational qualification of admission to such course of study;
- iii) in reckoning the consecutive academic years during which a candidate has studied, any period of interruption of his/her study by reason of his/her failure to pass any examination shall be disregarded. Any period of his/her study in a State wide University or a State-wide educational institution shall also be disregarded;
- iv) The question whether any candidate for admission to any course of study has resided in any local area shall be determined with reference to the places where the candidate actually resided and not with reference to the residence of his/her parent or guardians.

### **Local Area**

The erstwhile districts of Telangana Districts (33) Adilabad, Bhadrachalam, Kothagudem, Hyderabad (Including Twin cities), Jagtial, Jangaon, Jayashankar Bhupalpally, Jogulamba Gadwal, Kamareddy, Karimnagar, Khammam, Kumuram Bheem, Mahabubabad, Mahabubnagar, Mancherial, Medak, Medchal, Mulugu, Nagarkurnool, Nalgonda, Narayanpet, Nirmal, Nizamabad, Peddapalli, Rajanna Sircilla, Rangareddy, Sangareddy, Siddipet, Suryapet, Vikarabad, Wanaparthy, Warangal (Rural), Warangal (Urban), Yadadri Bhuvanagiri shall be regarded as the local area for the purpose of admission in respect of **Osmania University**.

**B.** The following categories of candidates will be considered against 15% of the available seats left **unreserved**.

- a) All candidates belonging to Telangana and Andhra Pradesh States.
- b) Candidates who have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of study outside the State or either of whose parents have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding period of employment outside the State;
- c) Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and similar other Quasi-Government Institutions within the State. Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State or Central Government, Public Sector, Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and similar other Quasi-Government Institutions within the state.
- d) Candidates who are employees in the State, Central Government undertakings, Public Sector Corporations, Local e) Bodies, Universities and other similar Quasi-public Institutions within the state.

In the case of candidates who passed B. Sc. (Ag.) / B. Sc. (Hort.) / B. Sc. (Home Science) / B. Tech (Dairying / B. Tech (Agril. Engg) / B. Tech (Food Technology) / B. Tech (Food Science) / B. Sc. (Dairy Technology) / B. V. Sc. Degree etc. from PJTSAU / ANGRAU only the period of study prior to joining the University will be reckoned for determining the Local/ Non-local status of the candidate.
